Heights Guitars Lee Road Store Has Now Closed Its Doors

Established in 1994 by a musician/high school teacher Greg Stiles, who died in 2010, Heights Guitars was THE consignment shop for used gear, vantage and new string instruments; and garnered rave reviews on the internet, like:

"Best guitar shop ever"

"...nice store, new stuff and old stuff"

"Probably the best service I've had in a store in as long as I can remember."

"...I really love this place"

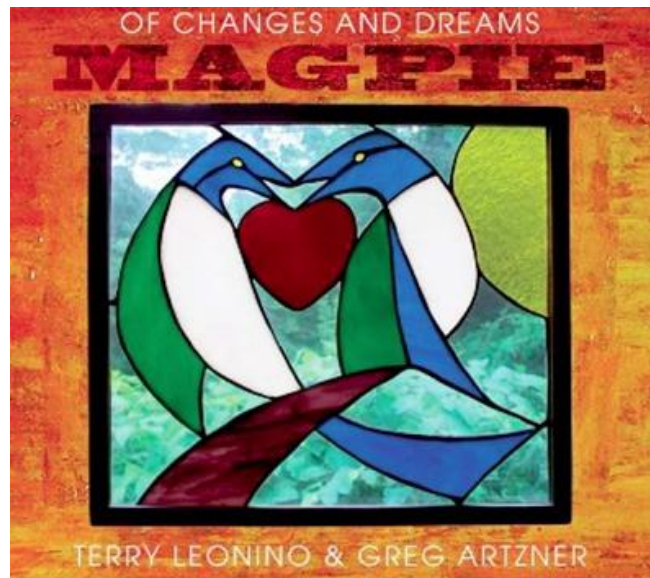

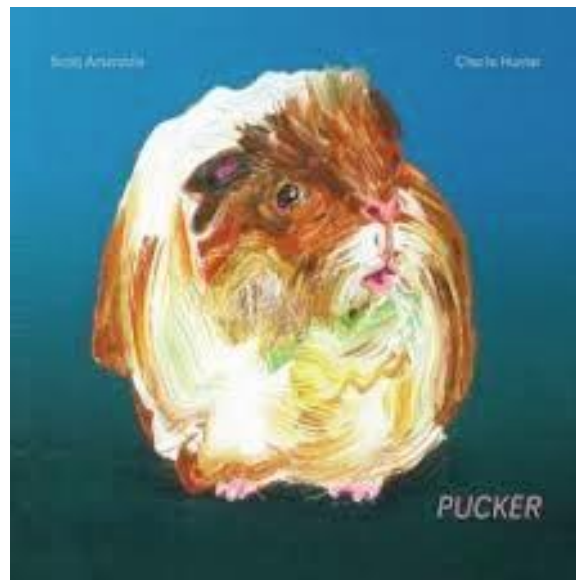

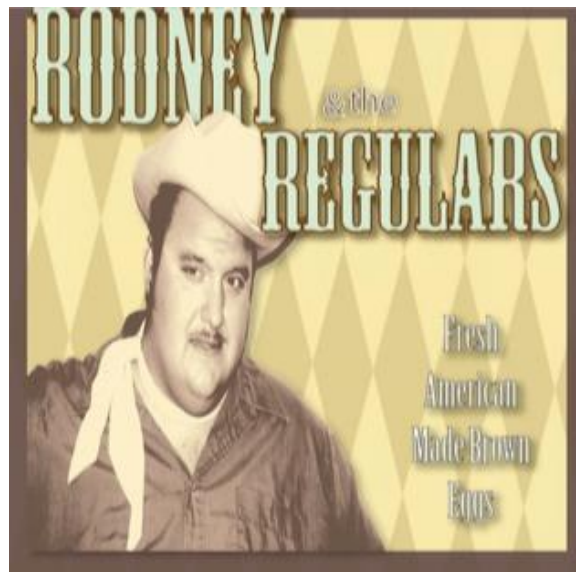
